When landfilled, gypsum breaks down into hydrogen sulfide gas—a hazardous, foul-smelling odor. This results in many challenges between the waste management industry and the communities they serve.

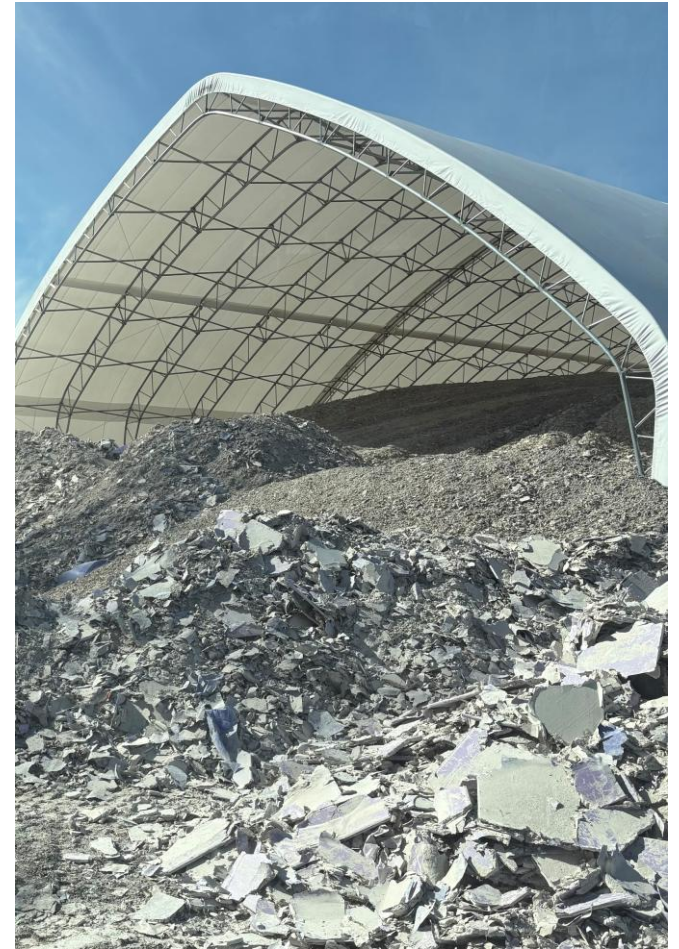


A Critical Resource in Short Supply

Gypsum is a critical resource for both the agriculture industry as well as cement manufacturing.

For decades, coal fired power plants created a byproduct – synthetic gypsum. This not only met the demand but created a surplus which was landfilled.

As these plants are taken offline what was a surplus is now an extreme shortage.



The Need For Gypsum

Drywall waste is a year-round issue. The ag industry needs this critical nutrient applied to the land over a brief 45-day period each year.

We solve this issue by storing the finished product under a 40,000 square foot building, keeping the material dry so it's easily spread by the farmers.

Gypsum is a necessary element in cement. Without it, cement would harden within minutes, rendering it unworkable. Without gypsum, the concrete industry would not exist as it does today.

Our solution: Meet the increasing demand for gypsum while providing a solution for both the drywall and landfill industries .
